Tamarack Resort COVID-19 Information and Updates

The health and safety of our guests, employees and homeowners is always our top priority.

To ensure that you can continue to enjoy recreating in the great outdoors during this time of uncertainty, Tamarack has implemented a number of precautionary measures against the coronavirus.

- Increased resort-wide cleaning using recommended antiviral and antibacterial chemicals
- Food service adjustments to remove self-serve items and replace shared public use items with single use options
- Hourly sanitizing of high-use dining area surfaces
- We ask guests to ride on chairlifts with their parties only

We ask our guests to follow public health recommendations including increased hand washing, covering of coughs and sneezes, and staying home if ill.

Tamarack plans to continue our winter operations through our projected closing date of April 5, 2020. We are, however, canceling some events which would bring large crowds of guests together. These events include

- Brewski, March 21 (credits for tickets purchased will be issued automatically in the coming days)
- Fireworks Show, March 28
- State of Idaho Pond Skim Championship, April 4th
