



SUMMER FACT SHEET

New for 2023

- **Camp Tam** – A four-day summer kids camp with mountain, meadow and lake activities.
- **Adventure Pack** – A lodging add-on offering guests discounts on a wide range of activities, including biking, kayaking, paddleboarding, pickleball, disc golf and axe throwing, through a convenient RFID wristband.
- **Sugarloaf Creamery** – A sweet shop in The Village at Tamarack featuring 18 ice cream flavors, milkshakes, bulk candy and a signature sweet of the day.
- **More Trails** – Saddle up for nearly five miles of new biking trails, bringing the total network to 32.7 miles.

Mountain Biking

Tamarack Resort's [full-service bike park](#), designed by International Mountain Biking Association experts, features nearly 33 total miles of lift-served downhill and cross-country trails for all levels of riders, with access to endless miles of U.S. Forest Service trails. Private downhill and cross-country lessons are available with the resort's Professional Mountain Biking Instructor Association-certified instructors. Guests can rent mountain bikes, e-bikes and cross-country bikes at Tamarack Outfitters, located in The Village.

- 18.7 miles of downhill single-track trails covering 1,700 feet of elevation
- 14 miles of single- and double-track cross-country trails
- Jump park and pump track located at the base of the mountain with features for all skill levels
- Tamarack Express chairlift is equipped with self-load, roll-on trays for downhill and e-bikes

Zipline Tours

Tamarack's [Zipline Tours](#) start at 6,700 feet above sea level and then zip down 3,500 feet of cable through a series of platforms to the valley floor, providing a bird's-eye view of the surrounding peaks, forest and Lake Cascade. Guests zip along at speeds up to 30 mph over creeks, canyons and the forest canopy while experiencing eight different ziplines, two suspension bridges and a 105-foot-tall treehouse.

Tamarack Waterfront

Located at Lake Cascade's State Park Poison Creek Recreation unit, [Tamarack Waterfront](#) is the outfitter for Tamarack's watersports. Non-motorized rentals include kayaks, canoes and SUP, while the motorized fleet includes personal watercraft and pontoon and wake boats. Wakeboard, wake surf and water ski lessons are also available.

Guided River Tours

Tamarack's experienced professional river guides provide [whitewater rafting](#) adventures on the 11-mile Cabarton stretch of the North Fork of the Payette River. Full-day trips last seven hours and include roundtrip transportation and riverside lunch.

Golf

Osprey Meadows [Driving Range](#) opens for daily use Memorial Day weekend. Clinics and private lessons for all ages and skill levels are available from Tamarack's PGA and Nicklaus Golf pros. Restoration is

currently underway on the resort's 18-hole championship golf course, [Osprey Meadows](#), with limited play planned for late summer 2023.

Disc Golf

A [nine-hole course](#) is located at the base of the mountain near the Discovery chairlift. Accessible from the main parking area near The Village and Wildhorse Children's Center, the course promises a fun experience for players of all skill levels. Discs are available for rent at Tamarack Outfitters.

Guided Fishing

Guests can enjoy [guided fishing](#) on Lake Cascade, a picturesque 30,000-acre lake with a variety of game fish. Guided trips run May 1–November 1, and reservations are required.

Axe Throwing

Located in The Village, the region's only outdoor [Axe Throwing arena](#) offers four lanes—each equipped with two targets.

Hiking

Trails accessed from the The Village or via a scenic chairlift ride to mid-mountain provide beautiful meadow and lake views. [Hiking tours](#) for all experience levels are available Saturdays and Sundays.

Pickleball and Basketball Courts

Just steps from the main parking lot near The Village are four [pickleball courts](#) and a basketball court. Lodging guests can check out pickleball sets at Tamarack Outfitters.

Camp Tam

Tamarack's new summer program for kids offers a variety of exciting activities, including biking the meadow trails, scenic walks, team building, golf, disc golf, pickleball and more. Camp Tam provides four days of adventure-filled fun every week between June 19 and August 19 (excluding the week of July 3) from 10 a.m.-5 p.m. for ages 7-12. Single-day Saturday programs are also available.

Adventure Pack

With this new add-on option for lodging, guests can enjoy a wide range of activities, including nonmotorized kayaking and paddleboarding, as well as cross-country biking, pickleball, disc golf and axe throwing. Upon check-in, guests receive an RFID wristband, providing frictionless access to Tamarack adventures.
