



TAMARACK RESORT OFFERS ROUND-TRIP “LIFTS” FROM TREASURE VALLEY

TAMARACK, Idaho (Dec. 5, 2019) — Tamarack Resort today announced the launch of the Tamarack Ski Bus for the 2019-2020 season. Beginning Saturday, Dec. 28, Treasure Valley skiers and boarders can enjoy round-trip transportation from Eagle Promenade (near the intersection of State Street and Highway 55 in Eagle) to Tamarack Village for \$20 plus tax.

The 56-passenger coach, provided by Caldwell Transportation, will operate every Saturday from December 28 through February 29, providing riders with comfortable reclining seats, an on-board restroom, free Wi-Fi and plenty of space for gear.

The ski bus will depart from the parking lot between PetSmart and Commercial Tire in Eagle Promenade (2948 E. State St.) at 7 a.m. and arrive at Tamarack Resort at approximately 9:30 a.m. For the return trip, the bus will depart Tamarack Resort at 4:30 p.m. and arrive at Eagle Promenade around 7 p.m.
