TAMARACK RESORT UNVEILS EXPANDED WINTER EVENT CALENDAR

Snowfort, fireworks, a laser light show, and opening of Wildwood Express highlight the season

TAMARACK, Idaho (Nov. 21, 2019) — Tamarack Resort today announced their 2019-2020 winter schedule, featuring both continuing and new events to attract and entertain guests all season long. The resort is scheduled to open on December 13, weather permitting.

Headlining the new attractions will be [Snowfort](#) on Feb. 28-29 — a spinoff of the annual Treefort Music Fest in Boise in March, which will feature two nights of live music along with various fort activities on the mountain. The artist lineup will be announced at a later date.

In January, the first ever [Light Up the Sky Laser and Music Show](#) will treat guests to lights, lasers and smoke projected into the sky, onto the slopes and set to music. The event is free to the public.

Starting mid-December, Tamarack will host the [Gateway to Tamarack](#) program — a collaboration between Tamarack, Gateway Parks and Play It Again Sports, where participants receive two hours of private lessons at Tamarack, including a full-day lift ticket and full-day equipment rental upon completion of introductory group ski lessons at Gateway Parks in Eagle. The cost is \$30 per person (a \$490 value).

“There are so many exciting things happening across the resort,” says Brad Larsen, Tamarack general manager. “From new events, to the opening of Wildwood, to the first phase of The Village At Tamarack’s completion – this will be our biggest season in recent memory.”

Tamarack is nearing completion of the new Wildwood Express — a high-speed, detachable, 4-person chairlift which will provide access to intermediate- and expert-level trails that haven’t been reachable by lift since 2009.

“Wildwood is going to open up some great terrain for our skiers and boarders to explore on the mountain,” says Tamarack Mountain Manager Mike Lancaster. “We couldn’t be more enthusiastic for this winter.”

Other developments include The Village’s luxury ski-in/ski-out residences, which are nearing completion and are now available for purchase. The Village Market and Coffee Shop located in The Village at Tamarack are both set to open later this season.
