



The Village at Tamarack Fact Sheet

Nestled at the base of West Mountain in the heart of the resort, The Village at Tamarack is America's newest Alpine village. It is comprised of six buildings with a total of 47,000 square feet of commercial space housing guest services, resort operations, retail, restaurants and bars on the plaza level along with lodging and luxury residences on the upper floors.

Restaurants & Shops

- The Reserve: Alpine-inspired Northwest cuisine and craft cocktails
- Village Market: Groceries, sundries, beer, wine, sandwiches and salads to go
- Clearwater Coffee Co.: DOMA coffee, locally made baked goods and sandwiches
- The Rendezvous: Indoor food hall with open seating featuring four eateries
 - Triple B Diner: Classic 60's-style diner: breakfast, burgers and more
 - Crusty's Pizza: Hand-tossed, thin-crust sourdough pies and slices
 - El Pueblo Taquería: Fast-casual Mexican fare: burritos, tacos, Mexican beer, margaritas and more
 - Bumps & Brews: Beer bar serving up 12 taps with regional brews and ciders
- Seven Devils Taphouse: Mountain-casual pub with smokehouse favorites and an automated, self-pour tap wall with 40 regional beers, ciders and wines.
