Skiing & Snowboarding

Tamarack Resort offers 1,100 acres of lift-accessed terrain with 50 marked runs and three terrain parks. The slopes are served by seven lifts including three high-speed quads, two fixed-grip quads and two surface lifts.

Nordic Skiing, Snowshoeing and Fat Biking

The Nordic trails at Tamarack wind through the meadows and forested paths. With over 25 kilometers (15 miles) of machine-groomed trails and a wide variety of terrain, Nordic skiers, snowshoers and fat bikers will experience scenic views across the meadow and Lake Cascade and a great adventure. The trails are open every day from dawn to dusk.

Winter Sports School

Tamarack's certified instructors and coaches offer daily first-timer, private and semi-private lessons for all ages and abilities as well as camps and clinics for all experience levels.

- Trailblazers is Tamarack's multiweek children's program for children ages 4-12 geared toward kids who already have the basics of skiing and want to take it to the next level in a fun and team-based learning environment.
- Gateway to Tamarack is the resort's partnership with Gateway Parks and Play it Again Sports designed for people ages 13+ who are new to skiing and snowboarding.
- Backcountry Experience offers a mix of classroom and on-snow training for intermediate skiers and snowboarders wanting to learn about snow safety and off-resort skiing. The one-day class focuses on snow science, backcountry skiing skills, tactics, as well as snow safety, introduction to beacon use, and exploration of some of the best in-bounds powder stashes Tamarack has to offer.
