### Lift Operations

9 a.m.-4 p.m. MST, seven days a week

### Seamless Direct-to-Snow Access

Getting on the lifts will be quicker and easier than ever this winter thanks to the newly renovated snow front and improvements in the resort's direct-to-snow experience. Skiers and riders can save time and money by pre-purchasing day passes online and picking them up at any one of the resort's five pass-pickup kiosks located throughout The Village at Tamarack.

### Skiing & Snowboarding

Tamarack Resort offers 1,100 acres of lift-accessed terrain (2,000 total mountain acres) with 50 marked runs featuring open bowls, steeps and cornices to high-speed corduroy groomers and hundreds of acres of gladed tree skiing and challenging backcountry. The primarily east-facing slopes receive an average of 300 inches of snowfall and are served by seven lifts including three high-speed quads, two fixed-grip quads and two surface lifts. The mountain features four terrain parks:

- Showtime: The largest park featuring medium-sized features and jumps
- No Business: An expert-level park featuring large-sized rails and jumps
- Homestead: Features medium-sized jibs
- Disco: Small features and jumps, perfect for beginners

Tamarack's Nordic trail system features more than 25 kilometers (15+ miles) of paths that let guests on classic or skate skis, snowshoes or fat bikes wind through open meadows and woodlands while enjoying mountain-high views in every direction. The dog-friendly trails are groomed Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday mornings and are open every day from dawn to dusk.

### Sports School

Tamarack's certified instructors and coaches offer daily first-timer, private and semi-private lessons for all ages and abilities as well as camps and clinics for all experience levels.

### Guided Ice Fishing

Guided ice-fishing adventures are available on nearby Lake Cascade, where anglers can fish for jumbo perch, bass, rainbow trout and other species. Trips include guides, gear, bait and an ice shack. Snowmobiles available for additional cost.
